Awards Day Committee	Plan awards day luncheon including securing a venue, planning the menu, setup and clean-up afterwards.	Based on # of hours
Calling Post	Record and send messages to parents regarding upcoming events, school closures due to inclement weather, etc.	Based on # of hours
Career Day Committee	Plan and implement a career day event for the school. Schedule guests (businesses, parents, etc.) to share their experiences with our students. Also responsible for scheduling guest speakers to come to school throughout school term.	Based on # of hours
Chaperones	Attend field trips to help provide extra coverage. Chaperones may be asked to monitor a group of students and/or transport students to a field trip location..	Based on # of hours
Volunteer Readers	Come in twice during 9-week session to listen to students read to you. May report any day of the week with notice.	Based on # of hours
Computer maintenance	Service all school computers, install new software, etc.	Based on # of hours
Field Trip Committee	Plan field trips. Provide all details regarding field trip including cost, location and best days to visit site.	Based on # of hours
Fundraising Committee	Plan and implement ongoing fundraisers; includes setting deadlines and contacting vendors regarding product delivery dates. Help promote our ongoing fundraisers such as our GoFundMe and pancake fundraiser.	Based on # of hours
Grant Writer	Research grant opportunities for the school.	Based on # of hours
Hospitality Committee	Collect small tokens of gratitude to be given as thanks to parents throughout the school year	3 items = 1 hour
Lunch/Snack Committee	Help collect snacks to be sold at school. Also collect lunch items that can be given to students who leave their lunches at home.	10 items = 1 hour
Basketball game volunteer	Attend basketball games and assist with concession sales, ticket sales, and post game clean-up	Based on # of hours
Parent Council	Led by our Parent Liaison	Based on # of hours
Parent Liaison	Assist teachers by making phone calls, planning class parties, reminding teachers of student birthdays and coordinating with other parents to provide gifts for teachers at end of school year	Based on # of hours

School Clean-up Committee	Responsible for cleaning the entire school at the end of each 9-week session and cleaning front windows once a week.	Based on # of hours
Showcase Committee	Responsible for all aspects of planning the showcases including finding a location, insuring students are fed prior to start of showcase and arranging a clean-up committee to work after showcase	Based on # of hours
Merit Store Coordinator	Collects items for the merit store	5 items = 1 hour
Applebee's Fundraiser sales	Sale tickets to our Applebee's Fundraiser	2 tickets = 1 hour
Speaker	Schedule a visit to come speak to the students about their field of work/career	Based on # of hours
Uniform Committee	Organize the collection of gently used uniform items to be sold at the school for a nominal fee	Based on # of hours
New student referral	A new student who is referred and is accepted at Solid Foundation, will take care of 12 of your parent volunteer hours for this year!	12 hours
